The **Science of Reading** tells us that spelling is directly related to our phonics skills. Therefore, our goals work in conjunction with Reading and writing practices.

These programs and practices have proven to support students in building skills needed to progress along the 5 Stages of Literacy Development (below to the right).



1

Phonemic Awareness

focusing on, manipulating, breaking apart, and putting together sounds orally

2

Phonics (or "alphabetic")

linking written letters to their sounds
forming spelling patterns

3

Fluency

achieving speed, accuracy, and expression in reading

4

Comprehension

understanding the concepts read or heard

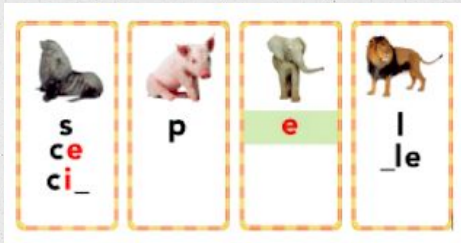

knowing words (both oral and written) and their meaning
